

Pilgrimage in Oaxaca 2011

Summary

Our tour starts in Oaxaca city, Oaxaca. We recommend flying into **Oaxaca** by **Tuesday December 6th** and back on or after **Tuesday December 20th**. Of course you may prefer to come earlier or stay longer; let us know and we will make hotel reservations for you. We urge you to book your flight as soon as possible.

You will be responsible for taking a taxi from the airport to the hotel; **Hotel Casa Arnel** at Aldama #404, Colonia Jalatlaco (neighborhood); tel.: (951)515-2856. Once checked in you can unpack and reassemble your bikes and we will store your bike boxes at the hotel for your flight home. On Tuesday December 6th we will meet by **6pm** in our hotel lobby for our first group dinner and our tour orientation.

Our route will take us from Oaxaca city, around a very challenging, mountainous route, to the coast for a short visit, then back into the

mountains, finally looping back to Oaxaca city. Over our 10 days of riding we will average 84km daily and cover a total of about 838km. We will travel entirely within the state of Oaxaca. Our daily rides will take us to various towns and cities including; Sola de Vega, Juchatengo, Juquila, Puerto Escondido, Santiago

After cycling back into Oaxaca city at the end of the tour, on Monday December 19th, you should disassemble and once again pack your bike in your bike box; ready for your flight home. Please allow plenty of time when you take a taxi back to the airport.



Count on a total of about US\$215 for accommodations (based on double occupancy); about US\$180 for food and drink; and about US\$120 for miscellaneous extras such as taxis, and entrance fees. Err on having a little extra and make sure to save a little money for souvenirs. Please note that in order to guarantee you a spot on the tour, the outstanding balance of the guides' fee must be received by us no later than October 6th.

Day 1 Wed Dec 7, 2011	Transfer to Zimatlan and cycle to Sola de Vega	66km	starts flat, end in the mountains, start seeing the pilgrims
Day 2 Thurs Dec 8, 2011	Sola de Vega to Juchatengo	51km	Challenging climb, spectacular descent
Day 3 Fri Dec 9, 2011	Juchatengo to Juquila	53km	Amazing views, challenging climbing
Day 4 Sat Dec 10, 2011	Juquila to Puerto Escondido	117km	Up, and doooooooowwwwwwwwwnnn... the Pacific ocean
Day 5 Sun Dec 11, 2011	Puerto Escondido	-	Rest Day. Small Resort Town. Surfer Beach, Mexican Resort Beach, Seafood, Nightlife.
Day 6 Mon Dec 12, 2011	Puerto Escondido	-	A second rest day. You've rested, now check out the local attractions
Day 7 Tues Dec 13, 2011	Puerto Escondido to Santiago Jamiltepec	110km	Beautiful foothills and distant mountains. Colonial mountain town
Day 8 Wed Dec 14, 2011	Santiago Jamiltepec to Cacahuatepec	80km	gentle climbs, Pinotepa market, foothills
Day 9 Thurs Dec 15, 2011	Cacahuatepec to Putla	87km	more climbing, small towns, gentle mountains
Day 10 Fri Dec 16, 2011	Putla to Tlaxiaco	88km	serious climbing, breath-taking views, little Paris
Day 11 Sat Dec 17, 2011	Tlaxiaco	-	Rest day. Little Paris. Huge weekly market
Day 12 Sun Dec 18, 2011	Tlaxiaco to Nochixtlan	83km	small towns, rolling countryside, huge church
Day 13 Mon Dec 19, 2011	Nochixtlan to Oaxaca city	103km	Hard day, 50km along a high ridge, great views on both sides
Day 14 Tues Dec 20, 2011	Oaxaca city	-	Stay a bit longer or fly back home
